

George Stephen Davis was born at Valton, Wisconsin, May 13, 1862. At the age of nine years his parents moved to Mahaska county, Iowa; afterward to Clay county, near Peterson. He was married twice. The first time to Anna L. Harvey at Greenville, ~~Ill.~~ She died September 14, 1902. The second time to Dona Neal. He leaves three daughters, four brothers, three sisters and his mother to mourn their loss. He was converted when a young man and joined the Free Methodist church some time afterward. He received his education at the Friendswood Academy, a Quaker school near Ironton, Wisconsin. He came to Colorado about nine years ago, and since that time has made his home in Boulder, Colorado. He was taken sick with rheumatic fever and infection about April 1 and died July 1, 1918. He manifested great patience throughout his long illness and spoke calmly of the end. He was held in the highest esteem by his friends and neighbors as a Christian man. The funeral was preached by the writer from 2 Cor. 5: 1. The body was shipped by his request to Greenville, Illinois, for burial.
